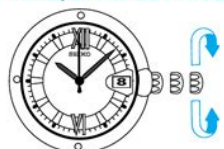

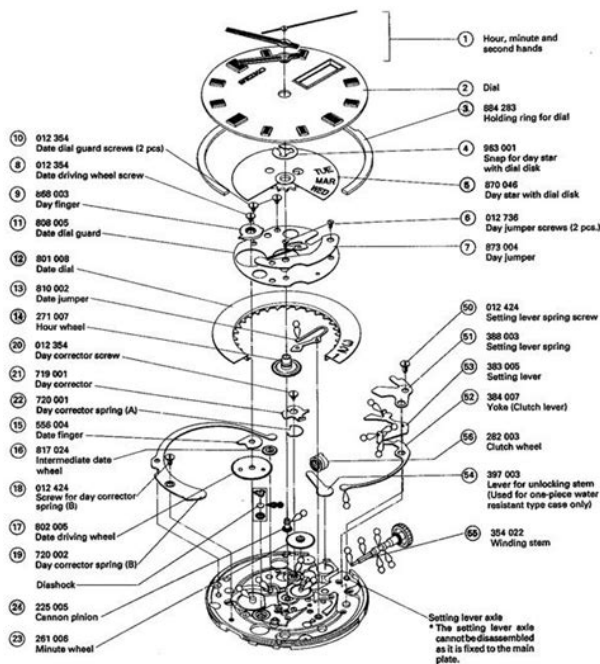

One went dead on me and I called out here on how to reset it. I put a new battery in in but it was 3 weeks after it stopped. She took it back to the high street Jewellery chain store where she originally purchased it to have a new battery fitted. When I removed the back the first thing I noticed was the lack of battery. On closer inspection I noticed there was Damage to the coil and after taking a closer look at things there seems to be damage to the circuit board. I am aware that these movements are obsolete and are no longer available nor is the circuit board. Does anyone know if there is a modern equivalent to the 8f32 that is in production that could be fitted as a replacement. The circuits are secured with very very tiny philips style screws and sometimes are quite tight. I think I will keep my eyes open for a second hand movement. Your question appears to be identical to another question that somebody asked and that persons never been seen again. But they did get an answer is posted below. Is not overly helpful because it assumes you will return the watch to them for the battery change. But I also have a battery change sheet which explains the setting and the service manual which also has setting instructions.

If you want to know how to change the battery or set the date scroll down. So the battery in my watch was dying as indicated the seconds hand updating every two seconds instead of every second. I used it like this for several weeks as once I put the watch on in the morning after an hour or two it would work normally maybe once it warmed up; seems to me you can squeeze a bit more juice out of batteries if you warm them up. Anyway, when the date stopped updating I decided it was time to get a new battery. Big mistake! I took it in to the watch repair place in sears but he couldnt get the backplate off neither could I for that matter; I tried to do it myself but it wouldnt go. So, then I took it to a jewelry store and they pointed me in the direction of a real watch repair shop, La Swiss in Richmond, BC, Canada. And thats where my trouble began. First, since this is a perpetual calendar; the normal watch repairman couldnt change the batter because after changing the battery the watch had to be reset. Ok, so I left the watch with them so the other guy could get it changed. However, the very next day it started doing the same thing again; skipping seconds and not updating the calendar. At first I thought that they hadnt changed the battery at all the first time around and maybe it just started working normally once he opened it up; I didnt know so I took it back. So I politely refused and took my watch home; mystified that it was toast already. Interestingly enough, theres also a little note about what to do if the battery is out for longer than 3 min. This jumper resets the watch into its initial mode you need to have the battery in place for it to work. Bottom line the dude at La Swiss is incompetent and overcharges for doing nothing.

Id be really miffed if I hadnt figured out how to reset the watch on my own. There is a horizontal tab that clips the battery in place top left of picture. Install the new battery by sliding it up against the rigid tabs and then slipping it with the flexible tab. It will snap in nicely if you do it right. The seconds hand will stop moving when you have the jumper in place. When you remove the jumper the seconds hand should start moving at 1 second intervals normal operation. This will advance the seconds hand either 5, 10, 15, or 20 seconds corresponding to 1, 2, 3 or 4 years since the last leap year fyi 2004 was a leap year. Then it will go back to normal operation ie set the date and update the seconds hand. When I checked this with my watch I was 1 year past a leap year and the month was may actually 3 years and dec. So, to quickly set the set I suppose you could twist your crown thousands of times too! do the following Pull the crown out so that you are setting the time. The date dial will now go to the current year I THINK; at least it went to 5 for me, which makes sense since its 1 year since the last leap year. You should be able to hear the date dial updating and it says 6. Repeat until the desired year turns up. After setting the year to 7 I pushed in the crown and checked my leap years again and it correctly showed that there was 3 years since the last leap year; good sign. Follow a similar procedure for setting the month and date; just pull out the crown and then make contact between the jumpers. So thats all there is to it; not so hard after all. Sorry to hear the BS you went through Im from Vancouver too. I recently bought a SUS perpetual from the auctions here in Japan. The seller realized he could not reset it,so he sent it to his local store and they sent it

to Seiko Osaka, who cleaned and reset the watch and checked the gasket seal. Thanks for your instructions and photos. It will help others with perpetuals.

Kudos for figuring out how to set the calendar yourself. Nice tutorial. This should be in the FAQ. I don't let ANYONE mess with my watches, unless they have a shop that looks like it has been open since the Kennedy Administration and are at least 60 years old. Sears No way! Mall jewelry store No! I learned this lesson very early, too. When I was about 18, I had a nice Citizen quartz 100m Diver. I needed the bracelet sized. So I took it to a jewelry store in the local mall. A very attractive young woman took my watch, and said she could resize it. The first thing she pulled out was a rather large pair of pliers. Needless to say, fifteen minutes later I got the watch back and the endpieces were all screwed up and the caseback had a huge scratch on it. Sears may be bad, but NEVER GO TO A MALL JEWELRY STORE. So thats all there is to it; not so hard after all. Have sent 2 8F35 movt for a battery change so far. But i sent it to a Seiko service centre. So thats all there is to it; not so hard after all. Considering you were flying blind as it were, you did very well to get things back on track. However, theres just one or two things that will make it easier next time. Firstly, the 5second jump indicates the calendar data have been lost. The guy at La Swiss had either not replaced the battery within 3 minutes, or he managed to short out the ve side of the battery and the circuit block cover. Either action will cause the calendar data to be lost. Repeat this procedure twice. If the date dial returns to the current date, and the second hand starts moving at onesecond intervals, the calendar data have been retained and youre finished apart from setting the time.

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If however the date dial doesnt turn, and the second hand starts moving at 5second intervals, the calendar data have been lost and you need to go through the resetting procedure see link below to Seiko Technical Guide. The 0 phi terminal is actually the first one and last one to touch after pulling out the crown two clicks. You use it to reset the date dial to 1. Once thats done, you then set the year, month and day as you have described, then touch the phi terminal again to check the date dial has gone back to 1. Now you can push the crown back in to its normal position. It seems very complicated compared to the normal nonperpetual calendar watch, and I suppose it is, but once you have the instructions its not so bad. I bought a ladys perp. Of course, it uses the 4F32 movement which is much smaller than the 8F32 gents movement, but specs are the same apart from battery life 810 years for the larger movements. The only drawback is that because you only have to touch it very infrequently, you forget how to do things and have to go hunting for the manual. Heres the LINK to the Seiko Technical Guide.
